Key highlights from 2017

- 2016/17 has been a very positive year for the charity and Penny Brohn UK have been able to support **15,000** people affected by cancer, more than in any previous year.
- Both the national centre and national services have achieved high levels of client satisfaction, at **94**% across all services for the year.
- Building on our internationally recognised Living Well service evaluation, the key statistics from our latest 12 month follow on report show 90% of clients said that 'yes', the course had enabled them to self-manage their health.
- We are also delighted to have built on our existing services and **expanded our Pathway of Care** this year; our **Pre-Treatment Support Clinic**, for all new patients starting treatment in Bristol, currently at 1,200 patients annually, held at Bristol Haematology and Oncology Centre (BHOC). Held at BHOC, this Pre-Treatment Support Clinic acts as the first step on the 'Pathway of Care' for cancer patients. The clinic supports men and women who are about to have chemotherapy or radiotherapy, in one comprehensive session as a standard part of every cancer patient's treatment plan at the BHOC. We are also in the process of implementing **End of Life and Bereavement Services** to offer further support to those with a terminal diagnosis and their supporters in the final stages of cancer, and beyond.
- Earlier this year we held our seventh Living Well Conference at our National Centre, which explored the legacy
 of the Realising the Value programme and the challenges faced by NHS England today. Our keynote speakers
 were Ian Benson, Head of Person Centred Care & Self Care for NHS England, and Dr Alf Colxclins who is a
 doctor, commissioner, researcher and national policy advisor for NHS England. The event was a huge success,
 tackling key sector issues and attended by a number of clinicians, our supporters, and leaders in integrative
 medicine.
